ORDER

Pursuant to the appellate order of the Council, New Delhi, No.F.No.89-247/2004-
Appeal dated 19th November 2004, the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE accords
recognition to **Teacher Training Institute (The Malnadu Educational
Charitable Trust), Thaliparamba, Kannur - 670101, Kerala** to offer
Elementary Teacher Training course of two years duration from the
academic session **2004-2005** with an annual intake of **50** students.

2. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14 of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Teacher Training Institute (The Malnadu Educational Charitable Trust), Thaliparamba, Kannur - 670101, Kerala** for **Elementary course of two years duration** from the academic session **2004-2005** with an annual intake of **50** students subject to fulfillment of the following.
 - a) The institution will ensure that **Six** faculty members are in position for an intake of **50** students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Committee immediately and in any case not later than one month from the date of commencement of the course.
 - b) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
 - c) The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (in case the course is started in temporary premises).
 - d) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
3. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC / University / State Government etc.,

4. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University for the appointment of faculty members and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
5. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

ORDER

WHEREAS The appeal of the Teacher Training Institute (Malanadu Educational Charitable Trust), Kannur, Kerala dated the 30/08/2004 is against the Order No. KL/ELE/N/100/SRO/NCTE/2004-2005/4648 dated the 05/08/2004 of the Southern Regional Committee, refusing recognition for conducting Elementary teacher training course on the grounds that 1) The institution has no E.T. lab. 2) Library facility is inadequate, and 3) Science, Psychology and E.T. Lab are to be equipped.


AND WHEREAS the Correspondent, Teacher Training Institute (Malanadu Educational Charitable Trust) (hereinafter referred to as the appellant), preferred an appeal dated the Monday, August 30, 2004 to the National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi (hereinafter referred to as the Council) under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the said Order.

AND WHEREAS Mr. K.P., Balakrishnan Nambiar, Chairman & Mr. P.K. Balagopalan Nambiar, Member, Teacher Training Institute (Malanadu Educational Charitable Trust), Kannur, Kerala presented the case of the appellant institution on the 08/11/2004. In the appeal and during personal presentation it was submitted that the ET lab as per NCTE regulations, has already been constructed and necessary equipment have been purchased. There are more than 2200 books in the library which has all the necessary amenities. Other Laboratories like Science , Psychology, Educational Technology laboratories etc. have also been well equipped. Necessary evidences like bills etc. were produced by the appellant in support of their contention.

AND WHEREAS a perusal of the documentary evidences the Council was satisfied that the institution had complied with the requirements of NCTE norms and removed deficiencies existing at the time of inspection which were minor in nature.

AND WHEREAS the Council after careful consideration of all aspects of the matter came to the conclusion that the Order of the SRC deserves to be quashed and the case of Teacher Training Institute (Malanadu Educational Charitable Trust), Kannur, Kerala be processed further by the SRC.

AND NOW THEREFORE, the Council hereby reverses the Order appealed against.
